Sample Register Report

- After login, select “Sample Registration” from drop down, if not selected. Click on ‘Sample Register’ link as shown below in Figure-1:

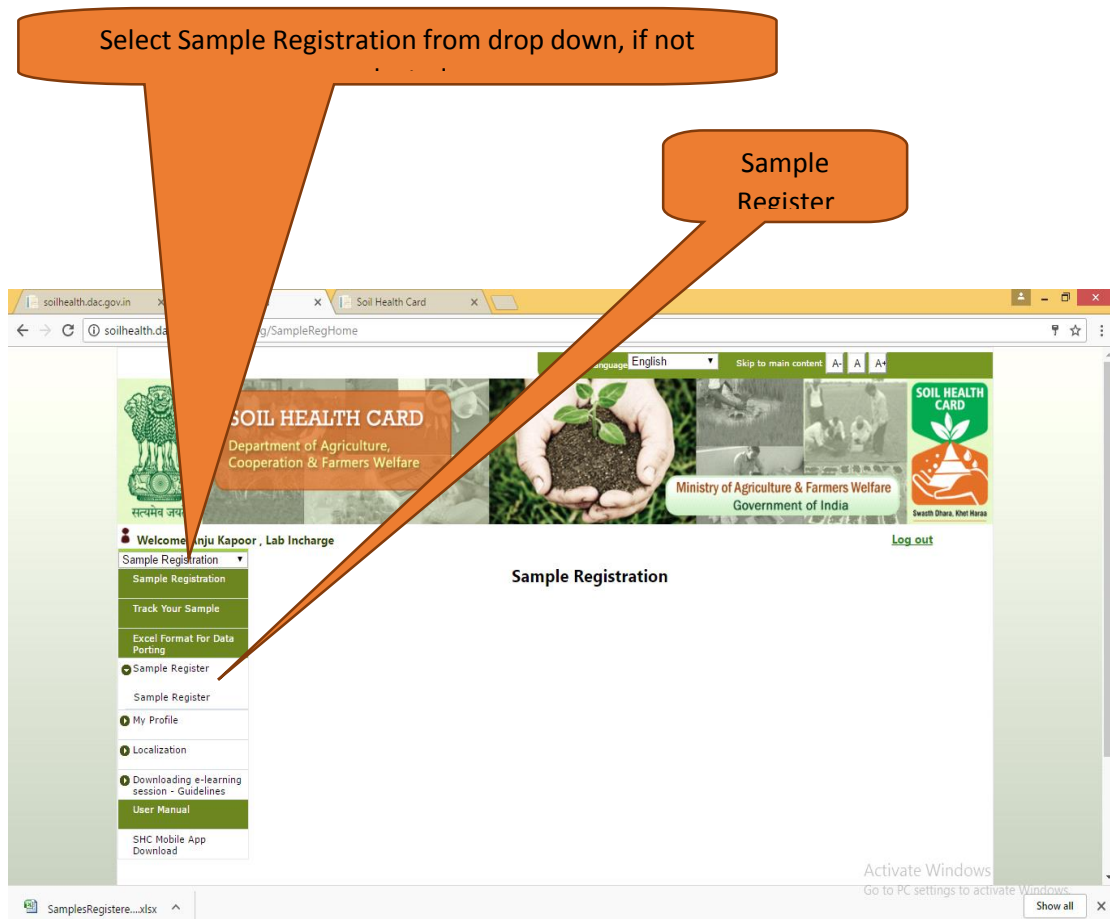

- After clicking on ‘Sample Register’ and selecting State, District, Sub district and Village, following report will be displayed along with Village Grid no and State Grid no as shown in Figure-2

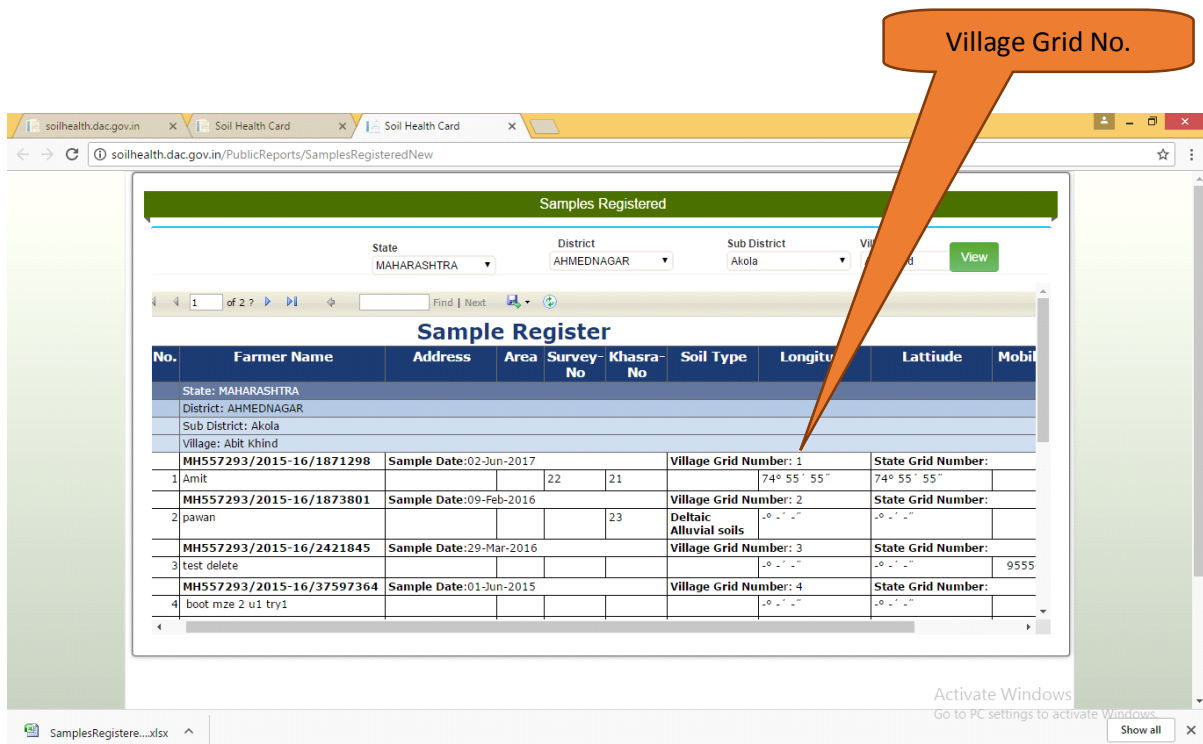

Sample Registration – Village Grid no

- After login, click on 'Registered Samples' link as shown below in Figure-2:

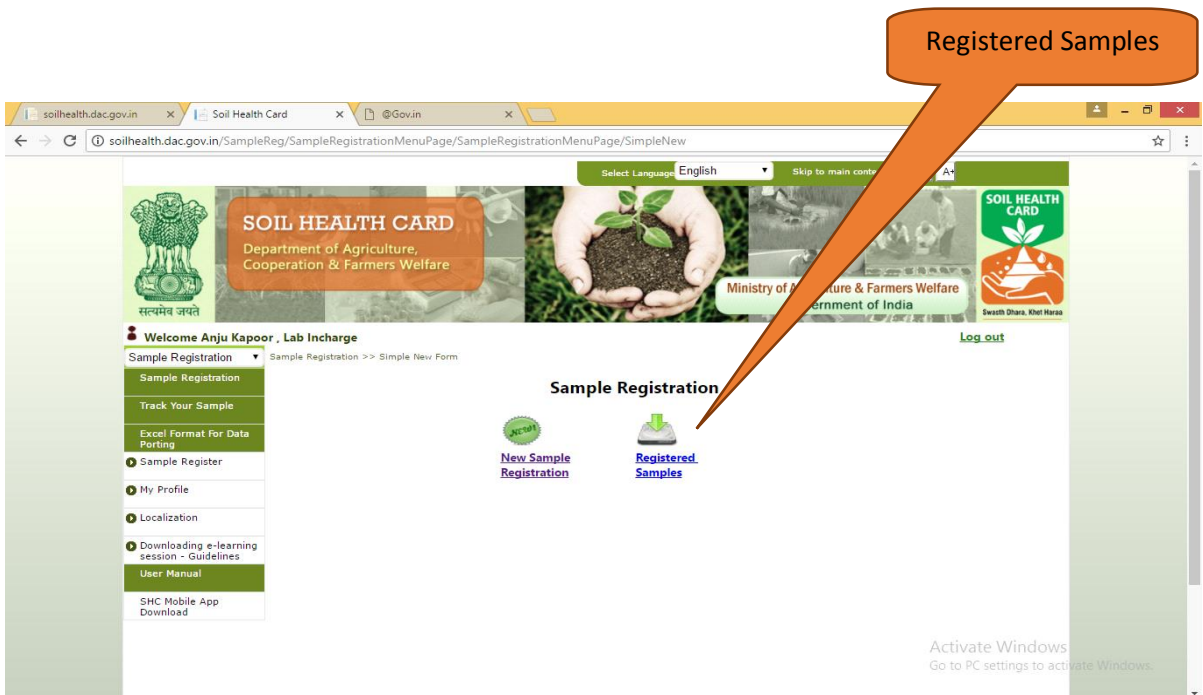

- After clicking on 'Registered Samples' link, following screen along with Village Grid no. will be displayed as shown in Figure-4 .

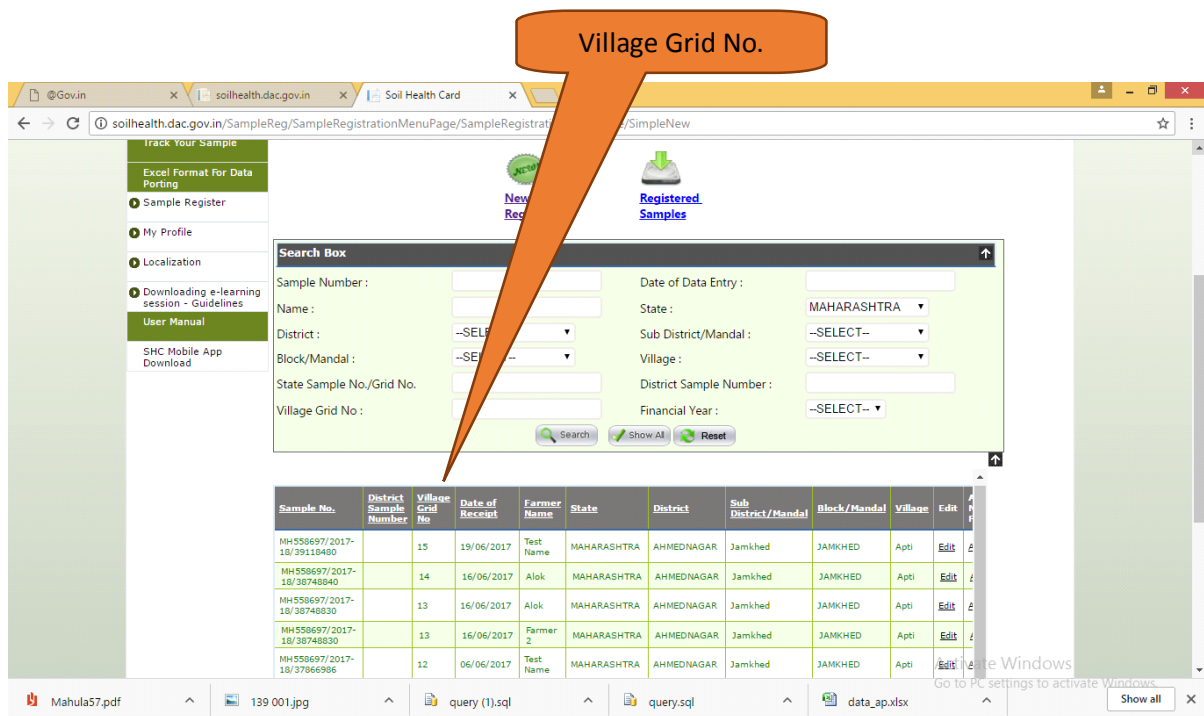

Usage of Village Grid No.

- It is very easy to remember.
- It can be used in mobile app as given below -
 - Print sample register using steps given above for a particular village from website (<http://soilhealth.dac.gov.in>). This sample register has Village Grid Number for each sample collected during first cycle.
 - Download data for village for which sample collection is being done.
 - When collecting sample for new cycle, give Village Grid No. of old sample in mobile app in option for New Cycle Sample Registration. It will fetch data of respective sample registered in old cycle. One can provide sample date of new sample and make changes if any and upload sample on the portal.
 - It will make the data entry work easier for new cycle.
